A Tuesday balance workshop will include a series of didactic teaching sessions in the morning, followed by a hands-on practical in the afternoon. Due to space restrictions, places in the workshop are limited, particularly for the afternoon practical session. The practical will take place within the School of Physiotherapy, 325 Great King Street, Dunedin and will include four work stations, providing an opportunity to gain hands-on experience with: video head impulses, vestibular-evoked myogenic potentials, posturography, and positional testing and particle repositioning manoeuvres. Keynote and other NZSBDV presentations will take place on Wednesday at the Dunedin Centre in conjunction with the NZSOHNS conference.

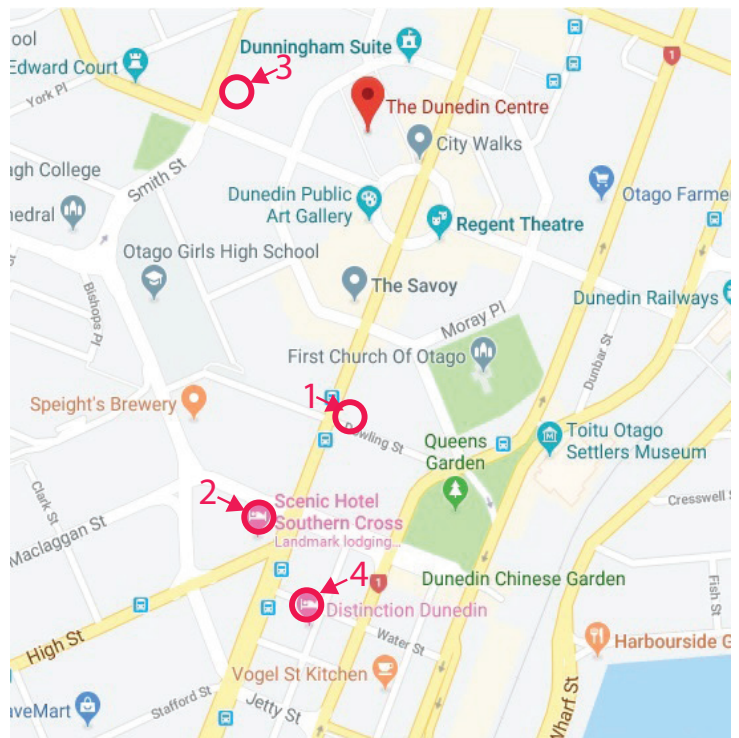
